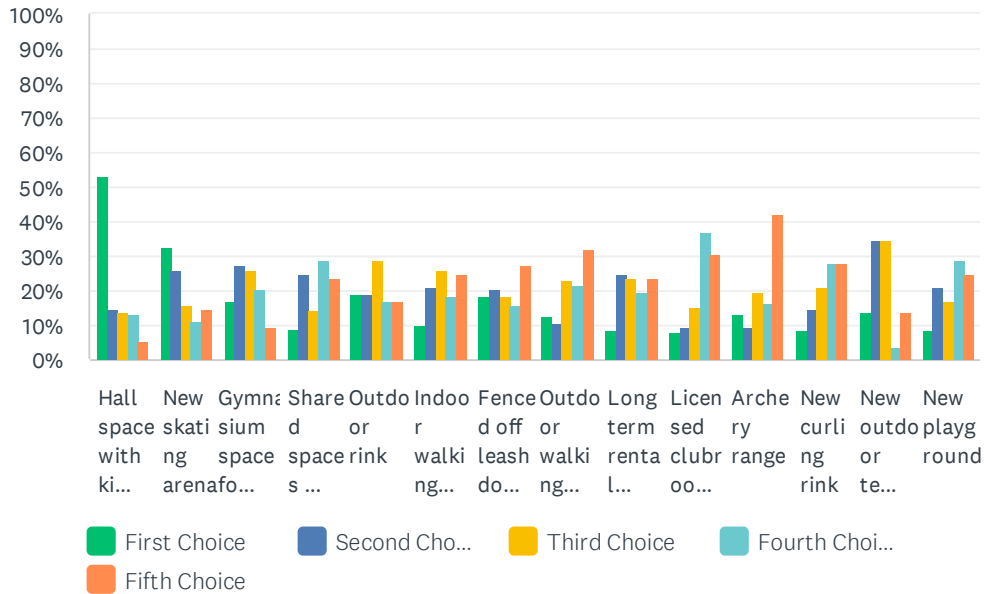


Q1 Considering all other facilities and spaces in town, what are your priorities for a newly designed multi-use recreation facility? (Rank your top 5 selections)

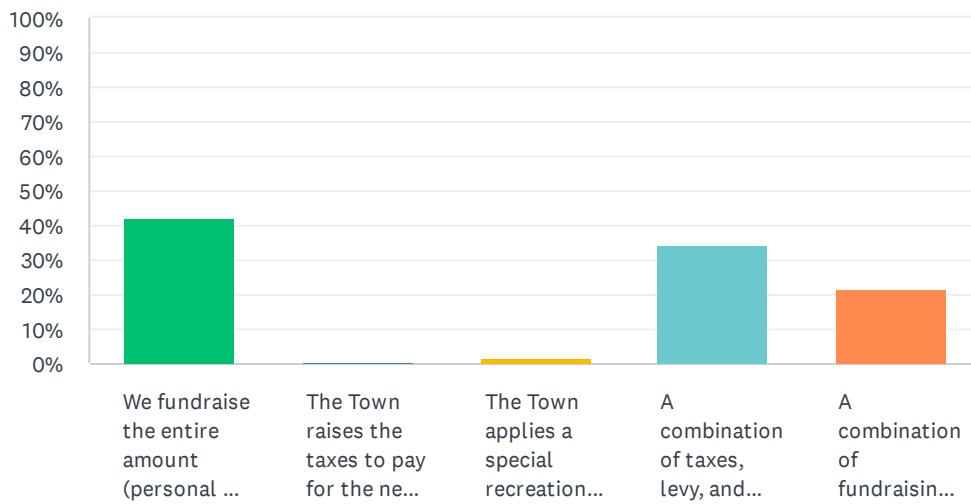

Q3 The multiplex will be developed in phases, based on our ability to raise funds. As a reference, the cost of the new pool was \$1.755 million. Note that building codes for public facilities require professional trades for all structure and utilities. The use of volunteers to reduce costs is very limited. The cost to build a hall with few additional features might be in the \$2 to \$4 million range. A facility similar in capacity to our current hall might be in the \$6 to \$8 million range. The cost of a new arena will be \$15 million or more How do we pay for it?

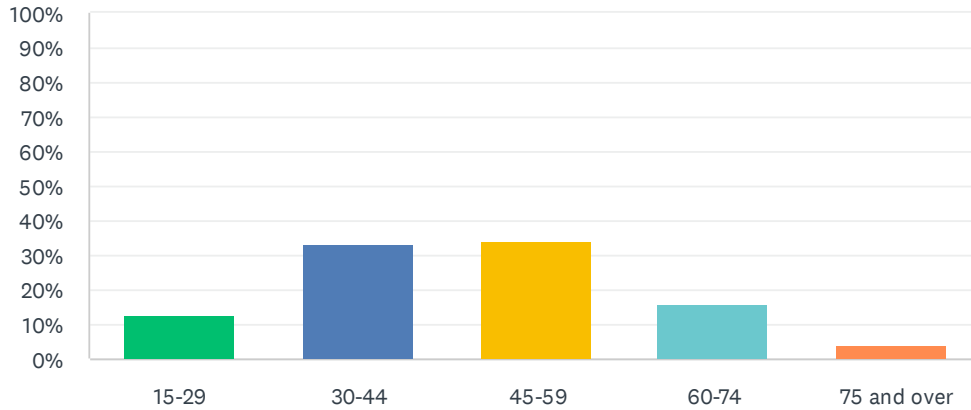
