

**BYLAW NO. 1134**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OXBOW TO FIX THE RATES AND FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER AND SEWER UTILITY SERVICES MONTHLY**

The COUNCIL of the Town of Oxbow, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set out in Schedule "A" attached; provided, however, that the minimum shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed.
2. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services a rental rate or service charge in accordance with Schedule "B" attached.
3. An 'infrastructure fee' of ten dollars will be charged each month for the purposes of increasing the capacity of the municipal wastewater facility. All fees collected will be held in a special purpose reserve.
4. The Galloway Health Centre is recognized as a vital community resource and shall be charged for no more than 35,000 gL, no matter the actual consumption recorded.
5. Accounts for water service and/or sewer service shall cover a period of one (1) month and shall be rendered on or before the fifth day of the month next following such period. Accounts shall be paid on the last day of each month following.
6. If an account is not paid within the period of thirty days, a notice to be pay will be issued and if not acted upon, the water service may be cut off. When the water service is cut off, it shall not be turned on until all outstanding amounts plus a reconnection fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) are paid to the municipality. Reconnection services outside normal working hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, will be charged a fee of one-hundred fifty (\$150) which must be remitted prior to the reconnection either to the Municipal Office by means of electronic payment or paid to the operator-in-charge at time of reconnection.
7. A penalty of three percent (3%) per month will be added to all water and sewer accounts outstanding more than 30 days.
8. On December 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year, any outstanding accounts more than 60 days will be added to the property taxes of the associated property.

THE rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of adoption by Council.

**SCHEDULE "A"****TO BYLAW NO. 1134**

- 1) The following monthly rates for water shall apply commencing October 1, 2022 and continuing until a new schedule is developed and approved:

	Per month
Minimum charge - first 2,000 gallons	37.82
2,001 to 10,000 gallons	4.10/1000 gL
10,001 to 25,000 gallons	5.01/1000 gL
25,001 to 38,000 gallons	21.12/1000 gL
Over 38,000 gallons	37.82/1000 gL

Unmetered water sold from the town tap:  
\$.50 per gallon with a minimum charge of \$50.00.

- 2) The following monthly rates for sewer shall apply commencing October 1, 2022 and continuing until a new schedule is developed and approved:

	Per month
Minimum charge - first 7,300 gallons	37.82
7,301 gallons and up	1.39/1000 gL
