Easy Steps to Block Party Success

Register your Block Party

The easiest way to get started is to register. If you prefer, you can register in person by completing the form at the back of this guide and bringing it to the Town Office or email it to development@oxbow.ca

Organize your Food

The Town of Oxbow and the Southern Plains Co-op will provide free hamburgers, hotdogs, and buns once a year to approved block parties.

- Please order food for only those who confirmed attendance.
- Food orders must be in by 10 am on the Monday prior to your party.
- Organize a potluck for desserts, sides, and snacks

Plan Fun Activities

- Download the Block Party Activities for some great ideas.
- Request a Recreation Loaner Bag

To Qualify for Approval

- Applications must be submitted a minimum of 7 days prior to the planned party
- Must include everyone on the block
- If inviting the side connecting street, everyone must be included on the side street
- Only include the people living on the blocks included in the party for food order
- Only one block party per Street or Ave, will be supported per year

	Getting Started Block Party Tips
	 Engage with your neighbours on finding a date that will work. Send an invitation to everyone. See attached document for a
	 template. Prepare for the weather. Consider an alternate location in case of rain or inclement weather. This may be someone's garage or party tent.
	Have activities suitable for all generations to encourage everyone to participate
	Invite neighbours to help with the party. For example, ask people to help with set-up, clean up, engage youth in planning kids activities, or ask people to bring food and chairs. People like to contribute and will be more engaged as a result.
	Remember alcohol is only permitted on private property, not town streets or parks.
