3. The town will block off the street if requested in the application/OR we will give the residents the permission to block it off themselves for the time set in their application.
4. The Mayor, Councillor, and/or Town representative will deliver the food, games (if applicable) on the requested day, and kick off the fun!

To qualify you:

- Must include everyone on the block
- If inviting the side connecting street, everyone must be included on the side street
- Only one block party per Street or Ave, will be supported per year
