OXBOW COMMUNITY GRANT

The Town of Oxbow is pleased to offer a grant program to non-profit organizations within the community of Oxbow.

GUIDELINES:

- Applicants must be a registered non-profit that provides an overall benefit to the community. Religious or political organizations are not eligible.
- The grant request must be for current capital or operating costs, small scale furnishing or fixtures, specific programming or special projects. Professional services, such as legal and accounting, are not eligible for grants.
- Maximum grant amount \$3,000.
- The deadline for applications is August 10, 2022. Please forward this to Lisa Pierce, Chief Administrative Officer, at administrator@oxbow.ca
- The Town will distribute 80% of the approved grant upon award with the remaining 20% to be disbursed upon receipt of proof of expenditure(s) incurred.

GRANT APPLICATION TO INCLUDE:

- Organization name, address, phone number, email address, and primary contact.
- A list of officers of the organization.
- A copy of the organization's non-profit certificate of status.
- A description of the organization's mandate, including the number of individuals/families served.
- The dollar amount of the request and a description of how the grant will be used.
- A copy of the most recent audited/reviewed financial statement.
