

BYLAW 1075
“A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF SNOWMOBILES
IN THE TOWN OF OXBOW”

The Council of the Town of Oxbow hereby enacts:

1. Definitions:

“Snowmobile Club” is a group of snowmobile operators recognized by the Saskatchewan Snowmobile Trail Association.

“Snowmobile” shall have the same meaning as that contained in *The Snowmobile Act* of the Province of Saskatchewan.

2.1 No person shall operate a snowmobile within the town limits.

2.2 Notwithstanding 2.1 Council, in consultation with a recognized Snowmobile Club may designate a route, within the town, that snowmobiles may use between the hours of 9am and 4pm.

2.3 Notwithstanding 2.1 the Chief Administrative Officer may authorize the use of snowmobiles within the town for special events and in cases of emergency.
