

BYLAW 10-88

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OXBOW FOR THE PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF FIREARMS AND SUPPRESSION OF NOISES IN THE TOWN.

Council for the Town of Oxbow, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw, the word "Firearm" shall be deemed to include any type or caliber of firearm or any type of air gun or air pistol.
2. No person shall, within the Town of Oxbow, discharge any type or caliber of firearm air gun or air pistol with the following exception:
 - (a) That by Resolution of Council, responsible persons may be delegated to dispose of suspected rabid animals, with the use of a 410 single shot shotgun.
3. No person under the age of fourteen (14) years shall, within the Town of Oxbow, carry or be in possession of any air gun or air pistol with projectile projected by air or a spring or a combination of both.
4. No person shall sell any firecrackers or fireworks in the Town of Oxbow.
5. No person shall ignite or discharge any firecrackers or fireworks of any type or size within the limits of the Town of Oxbow without first obtaining a special permit to do so from the Town Council.
6. Any person found guilty of any infraction of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Oxbow.
7. Bylaw No. 4/81 passed on October 28, 1981, is hereby repealed.
