

BYLAW 1122

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OXBOW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Town of Oxbow, in the Province of Saskatchewan, under the authority of Section 381 of *The Municipalities Act*, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw” of the Town of Oxbow.
2. Sections 3 and 4 apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Town of Oxbow for which no other fine is provided.
3. Subjection to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the Town of Oxbow, passed under the authority of *The Municipalities Act*, shall be liable to a fine or not more than \$2,000 and costs for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the Town of Oxbow, passed under the authority of *The Municipalities Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000 and costs for every offence.
5. Bylaw 11-88 is repealed.
6. This bylaw comes into force upon the third reading by the Council of the Town of Oxbow.
